## <Dormitory Stay Available During Vacation for On-Campus Programs>

For this year, the dormitory offers rooms for various on-campus programs taking place during the summer vacation. As such, please note that the vacation programs, which have been operating on a reduced scale for the past few years, will resume normal operation starting from the 2024 summer vacation. We kindly ask for the cooperation of all residents.

### 1) Vacation Programs

- \* E-House: Germany-Canada Faculty • Student Invitation Program / Huddling Choir Festival (elementary, middle and high school students)
- \* Hanwoori Hall: Short-term Korean Courses (Ewha Language Center)
- \* I-House: International Summer Campus Session 1 & 2, Summer Course Non-Ewha Participants, Ewha-Harvard Summer, Short-term Korean Courses (Ewha Language Center)

### 2) Notes

- \* Majority of vacation program participants are off-campus or non-Ewha participants
- \* Hanwoori Hall is open exclusively for female participants
- \* Male participants can be included in E-House and I-House vacation programs  
(Male students residing in E-House will be assigned to a different building from current residents)

※ Please be informed that residents are classified into the following categories based on the accommodation options they selected during the dormitory application process. Please carefully review this notice to ensure you are reading the instructions that apply to your resident type.

- **1-YEAR-Resident**: A resident currently residing in the dormitory who has applied for the entire academic year (including 1st semester, summer vacation, 2nd semester, and winter vacation) during the 1st semester dormitory application
  - **SEMESTER Resident**: A resident currently residing in the dormitory who has applied for only the 1st and 2nd semesters during the 1st semester dormitory application
  - **VACATION Resident**: A resident who has newly applied for only the summer vacation accommodation and has been assigned a room  
(If a current resident applies for and is assigned a summer vacation accommodation, they will be considered a VACATION Resident during the summer vacation period)

## 0. Notes

### [1-YEAR-Resident: Residents who applied for 24-Summer housing]

1. No application procedure is required as your residence has been confirmed during the initial housing application for 2024
2. If the housing fee payment for 24-Summer is completed, check-out and check-in procedures is unnecessary for residents consecutively living from 24-Spring to 24-Summer (continued residence in their current rooms)
3. If you cancel your residence for 24-Summer (including cancellation from failing to make the housing fee payment), the entire remaining residence period will be automatically canceled

### [SEMESTER Resident: Residents who did not apply for 24-Summer housing]

1. If you are a SEMESTER Resident who wish to live in the dormitory during 24-Summer, please apply as a 'Vacation Resident' during the application period for 24-Summer (ONLY living in Summer)
2. If a Semester Resident is assigned as a Vacation Resident, they must move-out from their current rooms before or on the 24-Spring official check-out day, and check-in to their newly assigned rooms on the 24-Summer (Only living in Summer) check-in day
3. Application period for 24-Summer (ONLY living in Summer): 2024.5.29(Wed)~2024.6.2(Sun)

### 3. Important Information

---

1. In principle, students are assigned to the current building/room that they have been residing from 24-Spring. However, under unavoidable circumstances such as repair work, they may be assigned to a different building/room from that of 24-Spring semester (if there are any changes, notification will be made)
2. Room/building type cannot be changed after the room assignment is completed
3. I-House is for international students such as exchange and language center students so male residents may reside in the same building
4. During the 24-Summer, non-Ewha participants can reside in the dormitories (E-House, Hanwoori, I-House). Especially, male participants can be included in the summer programs at E-House and I-House
5. As the dormitory is a community space, there may be various difficulties and inconveniences (noise, communication problems among room/unit mates etc.) so please consider carefully before applying
6. You may experience data disconnection while using Wi-Fi since internet connection will be simultaneously used by multiple people over the same internet line. If your Wi-Fi continuously gets disconnected, Hanwoori and I-House residents may borrow a wired LAN from the dormitory. However, please note that you must prepare a separate converter that connects the wired LAN with your laptop (there may be restrictions when participating in online classes or exams due to Wi-Fi instability)
