<Dormitory Stay Available During Vacation for On-Campus Programs>

The dormitory offers rooms for various on-campus programs taking place during the summer vacation. As such, please note that the vacation programs, which have been operating on a reduced scale for the past few years, will resume normal operation starting from the 2024 summer vacation. We kindly ask for the cooperation of all residents.

1) Vacation Programs

- * E-House: Germany-Canada Faculty Student Invitation Program / Huddling Choir Festival (elementary, middle and high school students)
- * Hanwoori Hall: Short-term Korean Courses (Ewha Language Center)
- * I-House: International Summer Campus Session 1 & 2, Summer Course Non-Ewha Participants, Ewha-Harvard Summer, Short-term Korean Courses (Ewha Language Center)

- * Majority of vacation program participants are off-campus or non-Ewha participants
- * Hanwoori Hall is open exclusively for female participants
- * Male participants can be included in E-House and I-House vacation programs (Male students residing in E-House will be assigned to a different building from current residents)

I. Eligibility

1. General Residents

Eligibility	 Those who wish to live ONLY in summer and meet the either requirements: 1) Students who do not live at the dormitory for 24-Spring but wish to do so for 24-Summer 2) 24-Spring Current residents** (1) Who did not previously request for 24-Summer housing (2) Who failed to receive 24-Summer housing for not paying the housing fee
	※ Applications received regardless of address; residents of Seoul can apply※ Students who took leave of absence are able to apply only for residence during vacation

* Ewha Law School students must apply to Soseul Residence

** <u>Residents who fall under criterion 2 will be assigned to a different room from that of 24-Spring for 24-Summer, so</u> there is a check-in/check-out procedure

IV. Important Information

- 1. Roommate/room type may not match your choice 100% and your roommate can be either an international or Korean student.
- 2. Room/building type cannot be changed after the room assignment is completed
- 3. E-House is a suite-style dormitory with single/double/triple/quad rooms where 2-10 people reside. The number of people assigned means the number of people allocated per room, not per unit
- 4. I-House is for international students such as exchange and language center students so male residents may reside in the same building
- 5. During the 24-Summer, non-Ewha participants can reside in the dormitories (E-House, Hanwoori, I-House). Especially, <u>male participants can be included in the summer programs at E-House and I-House</u>
- 6. As the dormitory is a community space, there may be various difficulties and inconveniences (noise, communication problems among room/unit mates etc.) so please consider carefully before you apply
- 7. You may experience data disconnection while using Wi-Fi since internet connection will be simultaneously used by multiple people over the same internet line. If your Wi-Fi continuously gets disconnected, Hanwoori and I-House residents may borrow a wired LAN from the dormitory. However, please note that you must prepare a separate converter that connects the wired LAN with your laptop (there may be restrictions when participating in online classes or exams due to Wi-Fi instability)

* Erase the last 6 digits of your ARC number when submitting documents

* Student will not be allowed to move into the dormitory without the required documents

1. Tuberculosis test (Chest X-ray) certificate (Korean or English) issued from 2024. 5. 1(Wed)

- A. Submit an original copy of tuberculosis test (chest x-ray) certificate (Korean and English certificates only)
- B. The tuberculosis test (chest X-ray) certificate should show the negative results
- C. Students who lived in the dormitory during 24-Spring do not have to submit the required document (regardless of dorm buildings you lived in)
