< On-Campus Residence Of Vacation Programs During Winter Vacation >

During 2024 Winter, room painting, window screen replacement and balcony repairs are scheduled at I-House A/B buildings, making I-House A/B unavailable for use. Hence, winter programs that were previously held at I-House will be located to E-House and Hanwoori House for this winter. We ask for your kind understanding and cooperation.

1) Winter Programs

- * E-House: 20 male students from International Winter College (Office of International Affairs) to be assigned to building 201
- * Hanwoori Hall: 80 female students from International Winter College (Office of International Affairs), Short-term Korean Courses (Ewha Language Center), Winter Course for Non-Ewha students

2) Notes

- * The majority of vacation program participants will be non-Ewha participants
- * E-House is scheduled to accommodate 20 male students
- * Hanwoori Hall is open exclusively for female participants
- * After the winter programs, a comprehensive inspection for any hidden cameras in the rooms used during the program will be conducted
- * Detailed schedules and participant information are to be announced

< E-House Heating Pipe Repair Notice>

During 2024 Winter break, heating pipe inspections and repairs are scheduled for the E-House buildings below. The inspections and repairs are to be conducted to prevent any leaks within the dormitory so we kindly ask for your understanding and cooperation.

- O Date: January 2nd (Thur), 2025 February 14th (Fri), 2025
- Location: E-House, buildings 203, 204, 301, 302, and 304, B2-4th floors common areas and rooms that did not undergo inspection and repairs during 2024 Summer (5th floor excluded)
- O Scope of Work: Inspection of heating pipes by drilling into inspection holes in the living room ceiling of each unit and performing repairs if necessary
- O Notes:
 - Male workers accompanied by residential assistants will visit units
 - Each unit will take approximately 3-5 days to complete, and there will be noise and dust



- * Please be informed that residents are classified into the following categories based on the accommodation options they selected during the dormitory application process. Please carefully review this notice to ensure you are reading the instructions that apply to your resident type.
- 1-YEAR-Resident: A resident currently residing in the dormitory who has applied for the entire academic year (including 2nd semester, and winter vacation) during the dormitory application
- SEMESTER Resident: A resident currently residing in the dormitory who has applied for only the 2nd semester during the dormitory application
- VACATION Resident: A resident who has newly applied for only the winter vacation accommodation and has been assigned a room

(If a current resident applies for and is assigned a winter vacation accommodation, they will be considered a VACATION Resident during the winter vacation period)

- ② Before 2024. 12.16(Mon), room number & bed number are subject to change so make sure to check the final room number
- 1. Residents who are consecutively living in the dormitory for 24-Winter are NOT subjected to document submission or check-in procedures
- 2. 24-Fall current residents who have been assigned a room as a resident living only in 24-Winter are subjected to check-in/check-out procedure as below
 - Must check out on the official check-out date for 24-Fall by 3PM, 2024. 12.20(Fri)
 - Must check in on the official check-in date for residents living only in 24-Winter from 10AM, 2024. 12.24(Tue)
- 3. Room changes for graduate students (EGPP & GKS) in I-House 24-Winter:
 - ① Subject: Graduate students(EGPP & GKS) residing in I-House who are expected to live in the dormitory for 2025 spring
 - 2 Moving period: 2025.1.2(Thur) ~ 2025.1.3(Fri) 9:00~17:00



- 3 Moving procedures: Complete the move-out process in I-House and move to a new room in E-House
- 4) Details to be announced on the dormitory website
- 4. Room changes for students living in I-House A/B buildings in 24-Winter:
 - ① Subject: Students who are residing in I-House A/B buildings who are expected to live in the dormitory for 24-Winter
 - ② Moving period and procedures: details to be announced

3. Important Information

- 1. You will be assigned to the same building and room you are currently residing. However, if there are any inevitable reasons to do so, the Housing Office may assign you to a different room in 24-Winter
- 2. Any request for room/building change will not be accepted
- 3. I-House is for international students such as exchange and language center students and there may be male residents in the same building
- 4. During the 24-Winter, non-Ewha participants can reside in the dormitories (E-House, Hanwoori, I-House). Especially, male participants can be included in the winter programs at E-House and I-House
- 5. There can be noises and entry of workers to the building due to construction and repair work during 24-Winter
 - * E-House building 203/204/301/302/304: heating pipe inspections and repairs are scheduled
 - * I-House building A/B: room painting, window screen replacement and balcony repairs are scheduled
- 6. As the dormitory is a communal space, there may be various difficulties and inconveniences (noise, communication problems among room/unit mates, etc.) so please deliberate before you apply
- 7. If an urgent temporary relocation to an alternative room or guest room is required due to repairs in the dormitory, the assigned room may differ from the current room type.
- 8. You may experience data disconnection while using Wi-Fi since internet connection will be simultaneously used by multiple people over the same internet line. If your Wi-Fi continuously gets disconnected, Hanwoori and I-House residents may borrow a wired LAN from the dormitory. However, please note that you must prepare a separate converter that connects the wired LAN with your laptop (there may be restrictions when participating in online classes or exams due to Wi-Fi instability)
