Facility Construction Notice

During the 25-Winter Vacation period, facility maintenance work will be conducted in several dormitory buildings. We kindly ask for your understanding and cooperation to ensure that the construction proceeds smoothly and safely for the improvement of dormitory living conditions.

1. E-House Air Conditioner Replacement Work

- O Period: Late December 2025 Before the Spring 2026 Check-in Date
- O Building: E-House (Building 301)
- O Details: Replacement of air conditioners in all rooms and common areas
- Note: Noise and dust may occur during the construction period

2. I-House Building A Air Conditioner Replacement & Building C Remodeling Work

- O Period: Early January 2026 Before the Spring 2026 Check-in Date
- O Buildings: I-House Buildings A and C
- O Details: Replacement of air conditioners in Building A rooms and remodeling work in Building C
- O Note: For residents staying in Buildings A and C during the 25-Winter Vacation, a notice regarding temporary room relocation will be sent individually via email



- * Please be informed that residents are classified into the following categories based on the residence options they selected during the dormitory application process. Please make sure you are reading the instructions that apply to your resident type.
- 1-YEAR-Resident: A resident currently residing in the dormitory who has applied for the entire academic year (including 2nd semester, and winter vacation) during the dormitory application
- SEMESTER Resident: A resident currently residing in the dormitory who has applied for only the 2nd semester during the dormitory application
- VACATION Resident: A resident who has newly applied for only the winter vacation accommodation and has been assigned a room

(If a current resident applies for and is assigned a winter vacation accommodation, they will be considered a VACATION Resident during the winter vacation period)

- * Early check-in before the official check-in date is not available
- * After the official check-in date, you can check-in during weekdays from 10:00 to 17:00
- * Check-in is not available on weekdays evenings (after 17:00), weekends and holidays
- * 1-Year Residents are NOT subjected to document submission or check-in/check-out procedures

2. Check-in Process

- * Please make sure to check your final room/bed number on EUREKA. If you put your belongings in the wrong room, you will get demerit points
- 1) 1-Year-Resident: No check-in process necessary
- 2) VACATION Resident Who Fall Into Either of the Two:

A. 25-Fall residents who are re-entering the dormitory after being selected as a 25-Winter-Only resident



B. Those who are newly entering the dormitory after being confirmed as a 25-Winter-Only resident

Visit the check-in venue of the dormitory you have been assigned

- → Submit all the required documents* and have them checked
- \rightarrow Receive your unit / room password and entrance card \rightarrow Check-in
- * Notes: If you were a 25-Fall resident and re-entering, you do not have to submit the required documents

3. Required Documents upon Check-in

- * All documents should be in hard copy (showing a picture of the document or sending an electronic copy is not possible)
- * In order to protect personal information, please erase the last 6 digits of your RC number when submitting documents
- * In case any document is missing or insufficient, students will be denied to move in to the dormitory

1) Tuberculosis Test (Chest X-Ray) Result (only in Korean OR English) Issued From 2025. 10. 1.(Wed)

- A. The tuberculosis test (chest X-ray) certificate must show negative results
- B. Students must submit the original or a copy (including printed photos) of the test result, which must include the student's name, tuberculosis test result, and the date of examination
- C. The test result must be either in Korean or English
- D. 25-Fall residents who are re-entering for winter vacation are exempt from submission

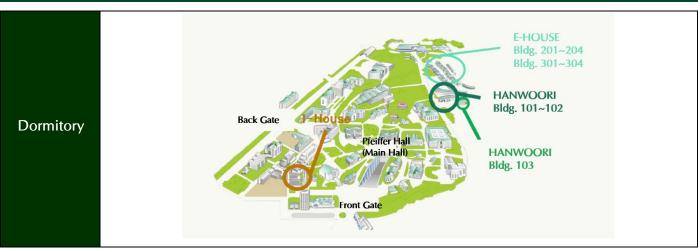
4. Important Information

- 1. Any request for room/building change will not be accepted
- 2. As the dormitory is a community space, there may be various difficulties and inconveniences (noise, communication problems among room/unit mates etc.)
- 3. E-House is a suite-style dormitory with single/double/triple/quad rooms in 2-10 person suites. The number of people assigned means the number of people allocated per room, not per unit
- 4. I-House is for international students such as exchange and language center students so male residents may reside in the same building
- 5. During the 25-Winter, non-Ewha participants can reside in the dormitories (E-House, Hanwoori, I-House). In particular, I-House may accommodate male participants
- 6. There can be noises and entry of workers to the building due to construction and repair work during 25-Winter
 - E-House: Building 301 Air Conditioner Replacement Work
 - I-House: Building A Air Conditioner Replacement & Building C Remodeling Work
- 7. If the dormitory is subjected to any maintenance work, there can be noises and entry of workers accompanied by staff members to the building
- 8. If an urgent temporary relocation to an alternative room or guest room is required due to repairs in the dormitory, the assigned room may differ from the current room type
- 9. Wi-Fi connectivity may be unstable, as multiple users will be sharing the same internet line (unstable Wi-Fi may cause limitations in attending online classes or taking online exams)



- 10. In order to protect wallpaper from damage, driving nails to the wall, hanging posters, or any type of wall-hanging items are prohibited. (The Housing Office may impose demerit points and charge the resident for any costs associated with restoring the damage.)
- 11. E-House Bldg. 201~204 B1 walkway is for dormitory residents only. If an outsider is found on the walkway, they will be immediately stopped by the dormitory staff as well as the accompanied resident may be charged with demerit points
- 12. Curfew hours: 00:00~05:00AM-for undergraduates only (except for I-House residents)
- 13. You cannot visit the dorm room before the check-in date (early check-in is not allowed)

- 14. If you cancel your residency or leave the dormitory during the semester, all of your subsequent dormitory applications will be automatically canceled. If you plan to apply for residency again, you can apply from the next semester (those who cancel their residency or leave the dormitory midway cannot re-apply in the same semester)
- 15. If an applicant takes leave of absence, is dismissed, takes credits below the standard stated in the eligibility, or does not return from leave of absence, the Housing Office may revoke your dormitory application and you cannot re-apply for dormitory. Also, you have a duty to notify the Housing Office of any changes in your status. Otherwise, you will be evicted and not allowed to re-apply

8. Parcel Room for Mail & Packages

 The following address format should be used for your mail/parcel, including your room number and valid Korean cellphone number

- 2. The Housing Office advises 25-Winter residents to send their packages on or after December 23th in order to not get their packages mixed up with the already existing packages of 25-Fall residents
 - E-House Bldg. 301(B2F) Parcel room, Hanwoori Bldg. 101 Lobby, I-House Bldg. A/B B2 Lobby
- 3. The Housing Office does not keep your package and takes no responsibility for any missing ones
- 4. Carts may be borrowed in the B2 lobby of E-House Bldg. 203 / 1F lobby of Hanwoori Bldg. 101 / B2 Security office of I-House Bldg. A/B
- 5. Do not load personal items in the parcel room. They will be thrown away without any prior notice
- 6. Any mail and packages left in the parcel room for a long period of time will be thrown away and you will get demerit points. Special cautions are required for the delivery of food and any perishable items

9. Restriction on Visitors and Entry of Vehicle & Parking

1. Visitors NOT ALLOWED to enter the dorm buildings

During the entire check-in period including the official check-in day, only resident students are permitted to enter the residence hall. If an outsider (including your parents) is accompanied/visited into the dorm, you may be charged



with demerit points

2. Dormitory Parking Control

- 1) Vehicles are not allowed to park in front of the dormitory (can only stop temporary for unloading). Please use the ECC underground parking lot near the main gate or the back gate for long-term parking
- * As the parking space is limited, it is requested to leave immediately after unloading your luggage
- 2) During the check-in period, access to the dormitory may be blocked for a long time due to other check-in vehicles. Thus the Housing Office recommends students to send their luggage beforehand through parcel services, and bring only light luggage or carriers
- 3) One Parking pass to be given per person
