Facility Construction Notice

During the 26-Summer Vacation period, facility maintenance work will be conducted in several dormitory buildings. We kindly ask for your understanding and cooperation to ensure that the construction proceeds smoothly and safely for the improvement of dormitory living conditions.

1. E-House Air Conditioner Replacement Work

- Period: 2026. June ~ August
- Building: E-House (Building 203)
- Details: Replacement of air conditioners in all rooms and common areas
- Note: Noise and dust may occur during the construction period

2. E-House & Hanwoori Wi-Fi Replacement Work

- Period: 2026. June ~ August
- Building: E-House (all buildings) & Hanwoori Building 103 (Ottogi International House)
- Details: Installation of wireless access points (APs) and related cabling
- Note: Noise and dust may occur during the construction period

3. Hanwoori Broadcasting Line Improvement Work

- Period: 2026. July ~ August
- Building: Hanwoori Building 101, 1st floor hallway and rooms
- Details: Maintenance and improvement of broadcasting speaker lines in the hallway and rooms
- Note: Noise and dust may occur during the construction period

5. Required Documents for Check-In

- ※ All required documents for check-in must be submitted in hard copies (showing a picture of the document or sending an electronic copy is not possible)
- ※ For privacy protection, students are required to erase the last digits of their Registration Number before submitting any documents
- ※ Students will not be permitted to check-in if the required documents are incomplete

▶ Tuberculosis Test (Chest X-Ray) Result (only in Korean OR English) Issued From 2026. 4. 1.(Wed)

- A. The tuberculosis test (chest X-ray) result must show negative results
- B. The test result should indicate the student's name, tuberculosis test result, and the date of examination. Submission of either the original or a copy (including printed photos) is acceptable
- C. Those who resided in the dormitory during the 26-Spring semester are not required to submit documents when applying for summer check-in

6. Important Information

▣ Room Assignment and Residence

1. Roommate/room type may not match your choice 100% and your roommate can be either an international or Korean student

2. Any request for room/building change will not be accepted
3. As the dormitory is a community space, there may be various difficulties and inconveniences (noise, communication problems among room/unit mates etc.)
4. E-House is a suite-style dormitory with single/double/triple/quad rooms in 2-10 person suites. The number of people assigned means the number of people allocated per room, not per unit
5. I-House is for international students such as exchange and language center students so male residents may reside in the same building
6. **During the Vacation period, non-Ewha participants can reside in the dormitories (E-House, Hanwoori, I-House). In particular, E-House & I-House may accommodate male participants**

■ Check-in and Check-out

1. You cannot visit the dorm room before the check-in date (early check-in is not allowed)

2. Students who cancel their dormitory residency or move out during the semester cannot reapply in the same semester
3. If any disqualifying circumstances arise after selection, your dormitory admission may be revoked, and reapplication within the same semester will not be permitted. You are also required to notify the Dormitory Office of any changes in your status. Failure to do so may result in eviction, and you will not be permitted to reapply for the dormitory

■ Facility Maintenance and Construction

1. There can be noises and entry of workers to the building due to construction and repair work during the vacation period
 * E-House Building 203 Air Conditioner Replacement Work
 * E-House (all buildings) & Hanwoori Building 103 (Ottogi International House) Wi-Fi Replacement Work
 * Hanwoori Building 101 1st Floor Hallway and Rooms Broadcasting Line Improvement Work
2. If the dormitory is subjected to any maintenance work, there can be noises and entry of workers accompanied by staff members to the building
3. If an urgent temporary relocation to an alternative room or guest room is required due to repairs in the dormitory, the assigned room may differ from the current room type

■ Dormitory Life

1. **Wi-Fi connectivity may be unstable, as multiple users will be sharing the same internet line** (unstable Wi-Fi may cause limitations in attending online classes or taking online exams)
