Facility Construction Notice

During the 26-Summer Vacation period, facility maintenance work will be conducted in several dormitory buildings. We kindly ask for your understanding and cooperation to ensure that the construction proceeds smoothly and safely for the improvement of dormitory living conditions.

1. E-House Air Conditioner Replacement Work

- Period: 2026. June ~ August
- Building: E-House (Building 203)
- Details: Replacement of air conditioners in all rooms and common areas
- Note: Noise and dust may occur during the construction period

2. E-House & Hanwoori Wi-Fi Replacement Work

- Period: 2026. June ~ August
- Building: E-House (all buildings) & Hanwoori Building 103 (Ottogi International House)
- Details: Installation of wireless access points (APs) and related cabling
- Note: Noise and dust may occur during the construction period

3. Hanwoori Broadcasting Line Improvement Work

- Period: 2026. July ~ August
- Building: Hanwoori Building 101, 1st floor hallway and rooms
- Details: Maintenance and improvement of broadcasting speaker lines in the hallway and rooms
- Note: Noise and dust may occur during the construction period

※ Please be informed that residents are classified into the following categories based on the residence options they selected during the dormitory application process. When reviewing this notice, please check whether it applies to your dormitory resident type below.

- **1-YEAR-Resident**: A resident currently residing in the dormitory who has applied for the entire academic year of 2026 (1st semester, summer vacation, 2nd semester, and winter vacation) during the 2026 dormitory application
- **SEMESTER-Resident**: A resident currently residing in the dormitory who has applied for only the 1st and 2nd semesters during the 2026 dormitory application
- **VACATION-Resident**: A resident who has newly applied for a summer vacation-only residence and has been assigned a room
 (If a SEMESTER-Resident applies for and is assigned a summer vacation-only residence, they will be considered a VACATION-Resident during the summer vacation period)

- ※ You cannot check-in during weekdays nights (after 5PM), weekends and holidays
- ※ 1-YEAR-Residents are NOT subjected to document submission or check-in/check-out procedures

2. Check-in Process

※ Please make sure to check your final room/bed number on EUREKA. If you put your belongings in the wrong room, you will get demerit points

1) 1-YEAR-Resident: No check-in process necessary

2) 26-Summer VACATION-Resident Who Fall Into Either of the Two:

- A. 26-Spring residents who are re-entering the dormitory after being selected as a 26-Summer VACATION-Resident
- B. Those who are newly entering the dormitory after being confirmed as a 26-Summer VACATION-Resident

Visit the check-in venue of the dormitory you have been assigned
→ Submit all the required documents* and have them checked
→ Receive your unit / room password and entrance card → Check-in

* Notes: If you were a 26-Spring resident and re-entering, you do not have to submit the required documents

3. Required Documents upon Check-in

- ※ All documents should be in hard copy (showing a picture of the document or sending an electronic copy is not possible)
- ※ In order to protect personal information, please erase the last 6 digits of your RC number when submitting documents
- ※ In case any document is missing or insufficient, students will be denied to move in to the dormitory

▶ Tuberculosis Test (chest X-ray) certificate issued from 2026. 4. 1.(Wed)

- A. The tuberculosis test (chest X-ray) certificate must show negative results
- B. Students must submit the original or a copy (including printed photos) of the test result, which must include the student's name, tuberculosis test result, and the date of examination
- C. The test result must be either in Korean or English
- D. 26-Spring residents who are re-entering for 26-Summer are exempt from submission

4. Important Information

▣ Room Assignment and Residence

1. Any request for room/building change will not be accepted
2. As the dormitory is a community space, there may be various difficulties and inconveniences (noise, communication problems among room/unit mates etc.)
3. E-House is a suite-style dormitory with single/double/triple/quad rooms in 2-10 person suites. The number of people assigned means the number of people allocated per room, not per unit
4. I-House is for international students such as exchange and language center students so male residents may reside in the same building
5. **During the Vacation period, non-Ewha participants can reside in the dormitories (E-House, Hanwoori, I-House). In particular, E-House and I-House may accommodate male participants**

▣ Check-in and Check-out

1. You cannot visit the dorm room before the check-in date (early check-in is not allowed)

2. **(For 1-YEAR-Residents) If you cancel your residency or leave the dormitory during the semester, all of your subsequent dormitory applications will be automatically canceled. If you plan to apply for residency again, you can apply from the next semester (those who cancel their residency or leave the dormitory midway cannot re-apply in the same semester)**
3. If any disqualifying circumstances arise after selection (such as expulsion), the dormitory assignment may be revoked, and re-application for the dormitory for the relevant semester will not be permitted. Residents are

required to immediately notify the Dormitory Office of any change in their eligibility status after check-in. Failure to do so will result in eviction and disqualification from future applications

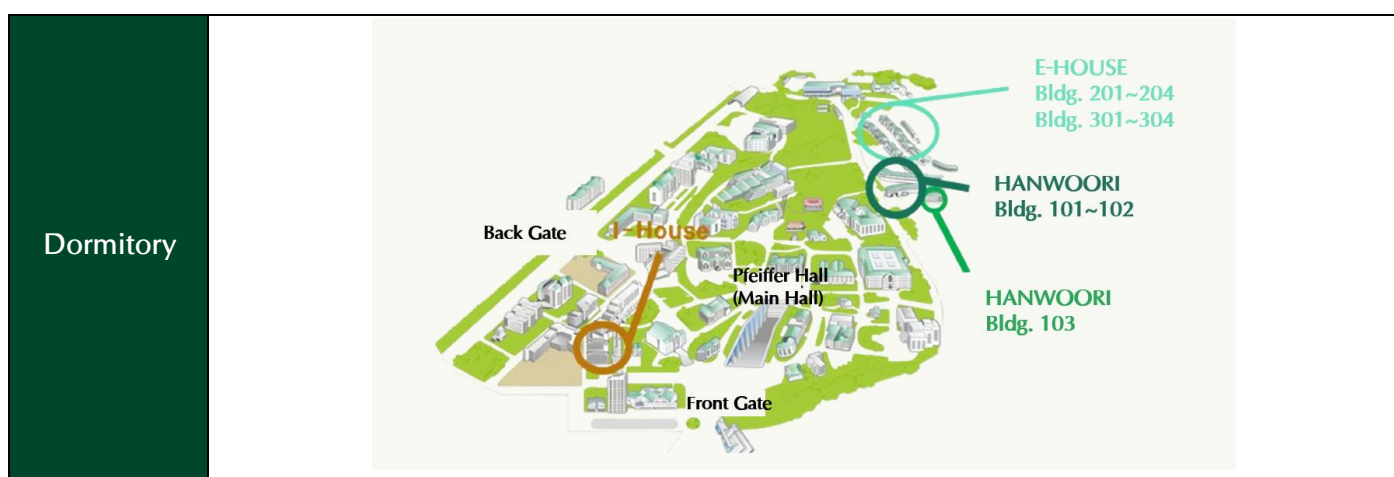
■ Facility Maintenance and Construction

1. There can be noises and entry of workers to the building due to construction and repair work during the vacation period
 - * E-House Building 203 Air Conditioner Replacement Work
 - * E-House (all buildings) & Hanwoori Building 103 (Ottogi International House) Wi-Fi Replacement Work
 - * Hanwoori Building 101 1st Floor Hallway and Rooms Broadcasting Line Improvement Work
2. If the dormitory is subjected to any maintenance work, there can be noises and entry of workers accompanied by staff members to the building
3. If an urgent temporary relocation to an alternative room or guest room is required due to repairs in the dormitory, the assigned room may differ from the current room type

■ Dormitory Life

1. **Wi-Fi connectivity may be unstable, as multiple users will be sharing the same internet line** (unstable Wi-Fi may cause limitations in attending online classes or taking online exams)
2. In order to protect wallpaper from damage, driving nails to the wall, hanging posters, or any type of wall-hanging items are prohibited (the Dormitory Office may impose demerit points and charge the resident for any costs associated with restoring the damage.)
3. E-House Bldg. 201~204 B1F walkway is for dormitory residents only. If an outsider is found on the walkway, they will be immediately stopped by the dormitory staff as well as the accompanied resident may be charged with demerit points
4. Curfew Policy
 - Applicable to: Undergraduate students of E-House and Hanwoori (not applicable to I-House)
 - Curfew hours: 00:00 AM to 5:00 AM

8. Parcel Room for Mail & Packages

2. The Dormitory Office advises 26-Summer residents to send their packages on or after 6. 29.(Mon) in order to not get their packages mixed up with the already existing packages of 26-Spring residents
 - ※ Due to the high volume of packages at the beginning of the check-in period, note that the space below will also be opened as a storage area: E-House Bldg. 202(B2F) SSG Hall / Hanwoori Bldg. 101 Weight Room & Lobby(1F)
3. The Dormitory Office does not keep your package and takes no responsibility for any missing ones
4. Carts may be borrowed in the B2F lobby of E-House Bldg. 203 / 1F lobby of Hanwoori Bldg. 101 / B2F Security office of I-House Bldg. A/B
5. **Do not put personal items in the parcel room. They will be thrown away without any prior notice**
6. **Any mail and packages left in the parcel room for a long period of time will be thrown away and you will get demerit points. Special cautions are required for the delivery of food and any perishable items**

9. Restriction on Visitors and Entry of Vehicle & Parking

1. **Visitors NOT ALLOWED to enter the dorm buildings**

During the entire check-in period including the official check-in day, only resident students are permitted to enter the residence hall. If an outsider (including parents) is accompanied/visited into the dorm, you may be charged with demerit points
2. **Dormitory Parking Control**
 - 1) **Vehicles are not allowed to park in front of the dormitory (can only stop temporary for unloading).** Please use the ECC underground parking lot near the main gate or the back gate for long-term parking
 - ※ As the parking space is limited, it is requested to leave immediately after unloading your luggage
 - 2) During the check-in period, access to the dormitory may be blocked for a long time due to other check-in vehicles. Thus, the Dormitory Office recommends students to send their luggage beforehand through parcel services, and bring only light luggage or carriers
 - 3) One Parking pass to be given per person
