※ Please be informed that residents are classified into the following categories based on the residence options they selected during the dormitory application process. When reviewing this notice, please check whether it applies to your dormitory resident type below.

- **1-YEAR-Resident**: A resident currently residing in the dormitory who has applied for the entire academic year of 2026 (1st semester, summer vacation, 2nd semester, and winter vacation) during the 2026 dormitory application
- **SEMESTER-Resident**: A resident currently residing in the dormitory who has applied for only the 1st and 2nd semesters during the 2026 dormitory application
- **VACATION-Resident**: A resident who has newly applied for a Summer or Winter vacation-only residence and has been assigned a room
- **New Resident**: A resident who has newly applied for the 2nd semester and has been assigned a room (even if a student lived in the dormitory during the 1st semester or summer vacation, they are considered as a New Resident if they submitted a new application and are assigned a new room for the 2nd semester)

▶ Residents who wish for 26-Fall Dormitory

1. Application procedure is not required for 1-YEAR-Residents as it has been confirmed during the 1st semester dormitory application
2. [1-YEAR-Resident \(students currently residing in the dormitory for both 26-Spring and 26-Summer\)](#)
 - Check-out process is not necessary once your room assignment for 26-Fall is confirmed after making the dormitory fee payment
 - **However, please note that you must newly complete the check-in procedure for 26-Fall (submission of Tuberculosis test result at the 26-Fall check-in booth is required)**
 - **If the 26-Fall dormitory fee is not paid, the entire remaining residence period (26-Fall and winter vacation) will be automatically canceled (re-applying for 26-Fall dormitory is NOT available)**
3. [SEMESTER-Resident](#):
 - After you make the dormitory fee payment for 26-Fall, you can check in on the official 26-Fall check-in date
 - **If the 26-Fall dormitory fee is not paid, the 26-Fall residence will be automatically canceled (re-applying for 26-Fall dormitory is NOT available)**
4. Under certain circumstances, the Dormitory Office may assign the student to a different room from 26-Spring (if there are any changes, a separate notice will be provided)

- **As the guaranteed residency period ends with the 26-Summer check-out date, international students admitted through the 25-Fall Admission must check-out on the 26-Summer official check-out date from their current dormitory buildings. Undergraduate students residing in Hanwoori and graduate students residing in I-House must check out by 2 PM 2026. 8. 25.(Tue).**
- Those who wish to reside at the dormitory for the 26-Fall must apply during the New Resident application period which will take place at the end of July

4. Required Documents upon Check-in

- ※ All documents should be in hard copy (showing a picture of the document or sending an electronic copy is not possible)
- ※ In order to protect personal information, please erase the last 6 digits of your RC number when submitting documents
- ※ In case any document is missing or insufficient, students will be denied to move in to the dormitory

▶ Tuberculosis Test (chest X-ray) certificate issued from 2026. 6. 1.(Mon)

- A. The tuberculosis test (chest X-ray) certificate must show negative results
- B. Students must submit the original or a copy (including printed photos) of the test result, which must include the student's name, tuberculosis test result, and the date of examination

- C. The test result must be either in Korean or English
- D. Residents who submitted the test certificate at the time of check-in for the 26-Spring must resubmit the certificate that meet the required examination date

5. Important Information

▣ Room Assignment and Residence

1. Students will generally be assigned to the same building and room they currently occupy for the Spring semester. However, if unavoidable circumstances arise, the Dormitory Office may assign them to a different building or room for the Fall period (if there are any changes, a separate notice will be provided)
2. Any request for room/building change will not be accepted
3. As the dormitory is a community space, there may be various difficulties and inconveniences (noise, communication problems among room/unit mates etc.)
4. E-House is a suite-style dormitory with single/double/triple/quad rooms in 2-10 person suites. The number of people assigned means the number of people allocated per room, not per unit
5. I-House is for international students such as exchange and language center students so male residents may reside in the same building

▣ Check-in and Check-out

1. You cannot visit the dorm room before the check-in date (early check-in is not allowed)

2. If you cancel your residency or leave the dormitory during the semester, all of your subsequent dormitory applications will be automatically canceled. If you plan to apply for residency again, you can apply from the next semester (those who cancel their residency or leave the dormitory midway cannot re-apply in the same semester)
3. If an applicant takes leave of absence, is dismissed, takes credits below the standard stated in the eligibility, or does not return from leave of absence, the Dormitory Office may revoke your dormitory application and you cannot re-apply for dormitory. Also, you have a duty to notify the Dormitory Office of any changes in your status. Otherwise, you will be evicted and not allowed to re-apply

▣ Facility Maintenance and Construction

1. If the dormitory is subjected to any maintenance work, there can be noises and entry of workers accompanied by staff members to the building
2. If an urgent temporary relocation to an alternative room or guest room is required due to repairs in the dormitory, the assigned room may differ from the current room type
